

Stable Value Fund

Investment Objective

The Fund is designed to provide investors with a higher return than money market funds while maintaining liquidity and safety of principal.

Investment Strategy

Approximately one-half of the Fund is invested in a guaranteed investment contract with Prudential Financial. The assets that back this contract are managed by the Fixed Income Group at Jennison Associates LLC, a Prudential Financial company. Jennison is widely recognized as a manager of high-quality fixed income investments for employee benefit plans.

The other half of the Fund is managed by Invesco Institutional, one of the largest managers of stable value funds in the country. Invesco invests in contracts issued by high quality banks and insurance companies. Each of these contracts is backed by a diversified portfolio of bonds that are held in trust for the Fund and are managed by Invesco, PIMCO, Blackrock, and Jennison.

Declared Interest Rates

An interest rate will be declared in advance each quarter. The new rate will be shown on an annualized basis and will reflect the yield and performance of the investment portfolio, including net deposits and withdrawals from the Stable Value Fund. The Fund's investment contracts ensure that the interest rate will not drop below 0%, so investors' principal and interest are protected except in the unlikely event of a credit default. The interest rate will be net of investment-related expenses. That Expense Ratio is currently 0.28%. Your plan may have fees for recordkeeping and administration that are not included within this Expense Ratio.

Who Should Invest


- Investors seeking interest income and safety of principal.
