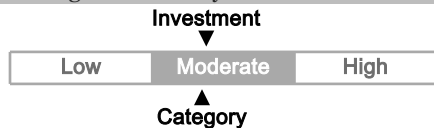

Investment Advisor	Vanguard Group Inc	<p>The investment seeks to provide capital appreciation and current income consistent with its current asset allocation. The fund invests in other Vanguard mutual funds according to an asset allocation strategy designed for investors planning to retire and leave the workforce in or within a few years of 2050 (the target year). The fund's asset allocation will become more conservative over time, meaning that the percentage of assets allocated to stocks will decrease while the percentage of assets allocated to bonds and other fixed income investments will increase.</p> <p>There is no assurance the objectives will be met.</p> <p><i>The target-date is the approximate year when investors plan to retire and may begin withdrawing their money. The asset allocation of the target-date funds will become more conservative as the target-date approaches by lessening your equity exposure and increasing your exposure in fixed income investments. Morningstar Volatility Rank As of 12/31/2019

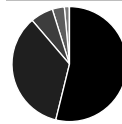
